Numbers- San Diego- DA & CA

- > 2015- 75000 videos- 40% deployed-
 - -- 15,000 hours
 - -- 12 TB
- 2016- 108,000 videos 45% deployed
 - -- 20,000 hours
 - -- 20 TB
- ▶ 2017- DA- 2.8 TB a month + CA
- ▶ 1700 cameras in 2015--headed to 2x

Retention and Storage

- What is the retention policy for evidentiary recordings vs. non-evidentiary recordings?
- Who decides what is evidentiary and how?
- How long are evidentiary recordings kept (misdemeanors/felonies/murder and other non-statute of limitation crimes)?
- Where will the recordings be stored?
- Who owns the stored evidence?
- How long will the recordings be retained if the state statute does not govern retention of evidence?



Staffing and Funding Issues for Prosecutors

- Who reviews the recordings?
- How many recordings will there be?
- Who redacts the recordings?
- Who stores the recordings both police and prosecutor?
- How will discovery be provided to defense attorneys?
- Are grand juries and courtrooms equipped to show recordings?
